Do you make use of safety lines when you are sitting on the suspended rail?			
Is it possible to activate the suspended rail without you sitting in the seat activating 2 buttons at the same time?

Are all the shields still placed as they were when the robot was new?			
Do you remember to pull out the electrical plug or to lock the main switch during repair?			
Is the bedding robot provided with an emergency stop device?
